CITY GUIDED BUS TOUR - \$7.00 per person. The city bus tour will be a 2-hour motor coach tour of the city. Along the way, we get off of the bus a few times to stretch our legs. The bus tour will include Charleston highlights in the historic district. We also visit the Citadel (Military College of SC) on this tour. As quoted by a website, "Tour Charleston, one of the most beautiful and historic cities in the south. Her stately homes with their lovely gardens, her magnificent public buildings and her majestic churches will captivate you. As you tour you will see the College of Charleston, early suburbs of the city, and of course our famous Battery with its elegant town houses built by planters and merchants in the 18th and 19th centuries."

After the city tour, we will enjoy lunch on our own and spend some time shopping and browsing in the Old City Market.

We will then re-board the bus that will take us to a ferry boat ride to Fort Sumter.

** For those that wish to forgo the Fort Sumter Tour, you may opt out after the City Tour/Lunch. For those that opt out, the NASH Shuttle located at the downtown visitor's center can be utilized to return back to the hotel.

FORT SUMTER TOUR - \$25.00 per person. As quoted by a website, "Visit the place where the American Civil War began in 1861. Begin your tour with a cruise through Charleston's historic harbor where you can catch breathtaking views of the city and watch sea gulls and dolphins play in the harbor. Upon arrival at Fort Sumter, rangers from the National Park Service will give you an informative introduction before you tour this famous bastion and its marvelous museum." Be advised, walking may be challenging at times on the Fort due to its configuration.

PATRIOTS POINT TOUR - \$30.00 per person (Includes lunch). As quoted by a website, "Tour Patriots Point, one of the world's largest naval and maritime museums. Visit the USS Yorktown, the famous fighting lady of World War II; the Destroyer Laffey, a participant in the World War II D-Day landings at Normandy; the Vietnam Experience Exhibit (Vietnam Era Support Base with its Sea Cobra and Huey helicopters); and the newly renovated Congressional Medal of Honor museum." Included with this tour is a BBQ lunch in the Chief Petty Officer's Mess aboard the USS Yorktown.
